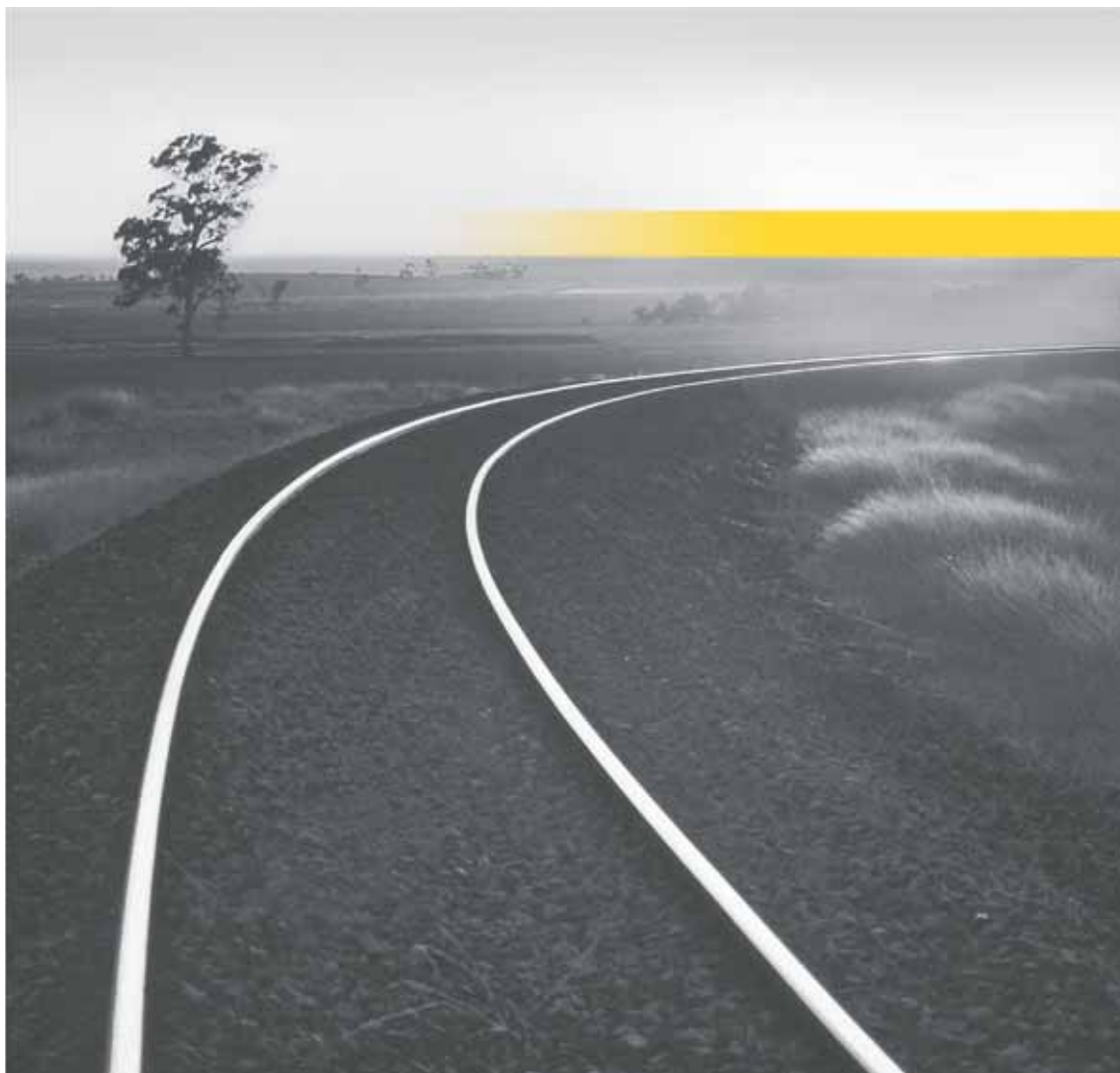
upgradeable to 1400 bogies per annum.
